

## THE USE OF CODE SWITCHING OF CXO MEDIA YOUTUBE CHANNEL (NSS EPISODE)

### **Abstrak**

Peneliti menerapkan metode deskriptif kualitatif dalam menganalisis data. Analisis deskriptif diaplikasikan untuk mengumpulkan data pada penelitian ini. Data diperoleh dari CXO Media YouTube Channel dengan memilih NSS Episode 1-10 dengan menggunakan teori oleh Hoffman (1991) dan Suwito (1985). Dimana data diambil berdasarkan ungkapan-ungkapan yang ada dalam tayangan video. Kemudian video tersebut dianalisis untuk mengidentifikasi jenis-jenis alih kode dan pada kolom komentar tayangan video tersebut dianalisis untuk memilih beberapa komentar dari pemirsa terkait penggunaan alih kode oleh setiap bintang tamu yang ada di dalam video. Peneliti menemukan alih kode inter-sentential, alih kode intra-sentential, dan alih kode emblematic, alih kode internal dan external di dalam tayangan video. Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan jenis alih kode intra-sentential lebih dominan digunakan oleh para bintang tamu di NSS Episode 1-10 dengan 78 penyebutan. Peneliti juga menemukan hasil dari mengidentifikasi kolom komentar, yaitu tanggapan positif lebih dominan dari pemirsa yang telah menonton tayangan video di channel tersebut.

### **Abstract**

The Researcher analyzed the data used the qualitative descriptive method. Descriptive analysis was used for data collection in this research. Data captured on CXO Media YouTube channel for NSS episodes 1-10. The theory proposed by Hoffman (1991) and Suwito (1985). The data were utterances from video transcriptions. Video transcripts were analyzed to determine the type of code-switching, and video column comments were analyzed to select viewer comments related to the guest star's use of code-switching in the video. The researcher has established inter-sentential code switching, intra-sentential code switching, emblematic switching (tag switching), external and internal code switching in video. The results of this investigation showed that the types of intra-sentential code-switching there are 78 utterances found in the guest stars of NSS episodes 1–10 was the dominant type used by guest stars. The researcher also found that positive comments were the most dominant among the comments from viewers who watched guest star videos.

## INTRODUCTION

Language is a means of communication, expression of identity, play, expression of imagination, and release of emotions. The focus of grammar and linguistics is on the knowledge of speaking a language, which is shared by all humans and the abstraction of language. The variation is an inherent feature of all languages and the patterns exhibited by this variation have social implications. In Addition, as communication system that uses signs to convey profound meaning. Signs used such as words, images, body language, sounds, etc. Therefore, it is the most important for human to communicate in daily activities. Because human is a social being that needs interaction. Based on that interaction, we use a language symbol. Sociolinguistics is the study of the relationship between language and society. It means that language use interacts with or is influenced by social factors such as gender, ethnicity, age and social class. For example, sociolinguists are interested in how we change the way we speak in different social contexts and how specific features of language are used to convey aspects of social meaning and identity. This is because you can choose specific chords or variants, so that you can easily discuss specific topics regardless of where you are talking. Talk about business during meeting or others activity. For example, we use language concerned to these areas instead of the language used for everyday voice talk at home. Simply use, when choosing code, sometimes we combine and switch languages when communicating with others. Bilingualism is the practice of two or more languages and becoming more common in many societies around the world. It is achieved by studying two languages simultaneously in childhood, or by learning the first language followed by the second language. In Indonesia, bilingualism is a top priority in improve language skills and children are often taught mixed languages since childhood. They can also bilingual, if they are constantly talking to them in different languages. People with bilingual or multilingual skills can switch languages. In the middle of their conversation, this phenomenon is namely code switching. For example, People switch in one language, language, dialect to another. Humans can perform code switches in any realm, in any situation. People living in bilingual areas tend to use more than one language in communicating every single day. They like to change their mother tongue or combine it with other languages, both local and international, especially in English. English as a language "Lingua Franca" has become a commonly used language in this world, including Indonesia. People are speaking not only one language in communication. We may use multiple languages depending on our communication needs. Also, the way you speak will differ depending on where you speak, when you speak, and the circumstances of your communication.

Nowadays, we can easily obtain visual and auditory information by watching videos. Full audio and visual material is available on the social media platform YouTube. On YouTube, guest stars from various backgrounds often use code switching when speaking on YouTube channels to which they are invited some guest stars in Podcasts, talk shows, etc. One of the YouTube channels where the guest star uses code-switching from "CXO Media Channel" in NSS episode of CXO Media Channel's show. Therefore, this study intent to focus on the case of using code-switching by guest stars on the CXO media channel program namely "NSS Episode". The point of this

research is to find out the types of code switching are used by guest stars in NSS Episode of CXO Media Channel and what are the positive and negative comments of code switching for viewers that used by guest stars in NSS Episode of CXO Media. From the statement background, the following of the research questions that is what types of code switching are used by guest stars in NSS Episode of CXO Media Channel and what are the negative and positive comments of code switching that used by guest stars for viewers in NSS Episode of CXO Media Channel.

Code Switching is a linguistic symptom that occurs in deliberate, causal action. According to Hoffman (1991) there are three types, which are inter-sentential code switching, intra-sentential code switching and emblematic code switching. Inter-sentential switching occurs when a speaker switches to another language after completing a sentence in one language. Intra-sentential switching is when speakers switch from one language to another in a single sentence. In code switching, speakers insert short phrases from one language into another without violating syntax guidelines. Tag switching is the use of tags or short exclamation points within the same utterance by a bilingual person. According to Suwito (1985) there are two types of code switching, which are internal and external code switching. External code switching when the language, such as from Indonesian switch to English or vice versa and Internal code switching: if the code is a variation of a transaction, such as the Javanese diverting their language from Java Ngoko convert to Krama.

## METHOD

This research included in qualitative research commonly called qualitative descriptive by that Analyze data based on three steps: Data Condensation, presents data (display data), and withgning conclusions or verification (Conclusion drawing and Verification (Huberman and Miles, 2014). Condensation of data refers to the selection process, simplification (simplifying), uncrimination (abstracting), and data transformation (transforming)). Because the data that wrote emphasizes more on the boiling observations of phenomena on the power of words and sentences used in describing the point of the research. The data obtained from the video through Youtube channel to describe code switching in NSS Episode of CXO Media Channel.

## FINDING AND DISCUSSION

The researcher classified the data based on the types of code switching that used by guest stars in NSS Episode 1-10 and the positive and negative impacts for viewers in NSS Episode 1-10 of CXO Media Channel on Youtube. For the types of code switching that found in the video, the researcher analyzed by using Suwito and Hoffman. There are three types of Hoffman's theory, which are Inter-Sentential Code Switching, Intra-Sentential Code Switching, and Emblematic Switching (Tag Switching). There are two types of Suwito's theory, which are External Code Switching and Internal Code Switching. Meanwhile, for the positive and negative impacts for viewers of code switching are used by guest stars in NSS Episode of CXO Media Channel, the researcher found the data through the comments of videos in NSS Episode 1- 10 by select based on the negative and positive impacts of viewers.

## CONCLUSION

The analysis results showed that 195 utterances of code switching in NSS Videos Episode 1-10 of CXO Media Youtube Channel. Types of code switching in these videos, the researcher founded 19 utterances of inter-sentential code switching, 78 intra-sentential Code Switching, and 23 Emblamatic Switching (tag switching). All of these types classified into 118 eksternal and 2 internal code switching. The guest stars in "NSS Episode 1-10" Which are Najwa Shihab, Boy William, Gaery Undarsa, Raditya Dika and Deddy Corbuzier, Noah, Nagita Slavina, Isyana Sarasvati, Zara Adhisty, Rizky Febian, and Yura Yunita use different types of code-switching during conversations. The data of negative and positive comments of viewers after watch the guest stars using code switching in videos showed that positive comments is the dominant reactions of viewers after watched the guest stars of using code switching in NSS Episode 1-10 on CXO Media Youtube Channel. The theory of this research was applied to a published video based on episode that uploaded two years ago on CXO Media Youtube Channel.

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
